PRODUCT NOTES:

- Climbers must wear fully enclosed rubber-soled shoes suitable for walking
- No loose items, including cameras, phones, and jewellery (such as necklaces, bracelet, drop earrings and watches, etc) will be permitted on the climb. Access to lockers to safely store any personal items for the duration of the climb is available.
- An attachment lanyard for sunglasses and prescription glasses will be provided
- RoofClimb operates in all weather conditions, with the exception of electrical and hail storms, or excessively strong wind conditions
- Climbers must sign a Declaration/Disclaimer Form, and complete a breathalyser test – anyone who records a blood alcohol reading on 0.05% or higher will be unable to participate in the climb
- For safety reasons all climbers must meet a minimum height of 120 centimetres, and a maximum weight of 136 kilograms fully clothed
- Children aged between 8 & 15 years inclusive must be accompanied by a paying adult, with a maximum of 3 children per adult
- Participants aged 75 years and over will need to provide a signed RoofClimb Medical Clearance Form from their doctor at the time of check-in
- Pregnant women (less than 20 weeks) require a signed RoofClimb Medical Clearance form from their doctor. Women over 20 weeks pregnant are not permitted to participate
- RoofClimb Conditions – need to be able to climb up and down ladders, climb up and down multiple flights of stairs, walk on open metal grate walk ways and stepped bridge, and be exposed to weather conditions including rain, moderate wind or heat

PAYMENTS & CANCELLATIONS:

- As per standard SeaLink Conditions
